Revelations 3:1-13

One of my daily readings this week started with 'Wake Up'.

The writer asked – 'Have you ever had that feeling in your life that everything is going well then suddenly everything falls apart?'

In the reading above, the city of Sardis thought they were impregnable and let down their guard but the enemy got in through cracks in the cliff face and took over the city.

This can also happen in churches where when the membership is high people sit back and give up mission work. Then when membership is low it is easier to enjoy fellowship together until it is time to call it a day.

Fortunately here at Trinity we have recognised that mission and outreach are needed and set up The Foundry and the ROC conversation. One of the benefits of having a Foundry Missioner is the number of contacts we have been able to make with Woking Council and other organisations. Through the ROC conversation, with many different organisations, we were able to discern the needs of people in Woking. We now have three action groups, working with a wide range of partners, to support:

Loneliness and isolation; mental health and wellbeing; and young people.

A wellbeing event in Woking Town Centre is planned for next year, we have also set up phone friends, laptops for schools and are bringing together all the youth workers in Woking.

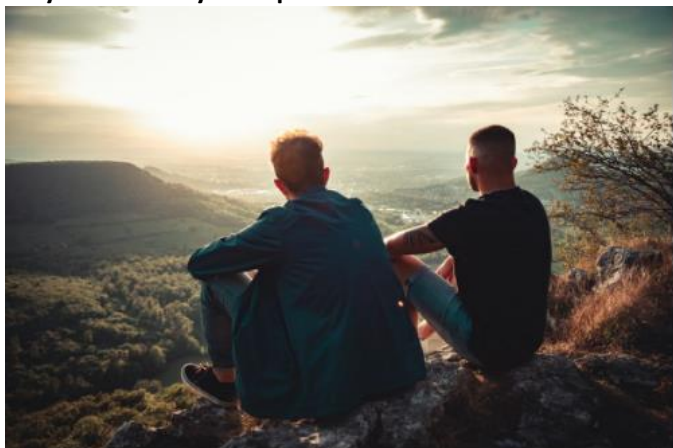
